Group-Early Start Denver Model

A fun, interactive early intervention for children with developmental delays particularly Autism Spectrum Disorder.

What is Group-Early Start Denver Model?

A therapeutic model that places children at the centre of teaching each other. G-ESDM intervention is delivered in a small group format and covers all learning areas for early intervention, including communication, social skills, imitation and more.

Who can do G-ESDM?

G-ESDM is for children with autism spectrum disorder or other developmental disabilities. Though research is geared towards autistic children, the teaching strategies and learning principles can be used for any child.

G-ESDM

- Supports rapid skill growth
- Uses neuroplasticity to promote brain connections
- Promotes engagement between peers
- Teaches multiple skills simultaneously



Benefits of G-ESDM Intervention

1. Is delivered naturally through play

In G-ESDM intervention, children are offered various teaching activities to engage with. The children select activities to participate in while the ESDM Practitioner embeds teaching opportunities.

2. Follows typical child development curriculum

G-ESDM follows a manualised program of natural child development.

3. Is comprehensive

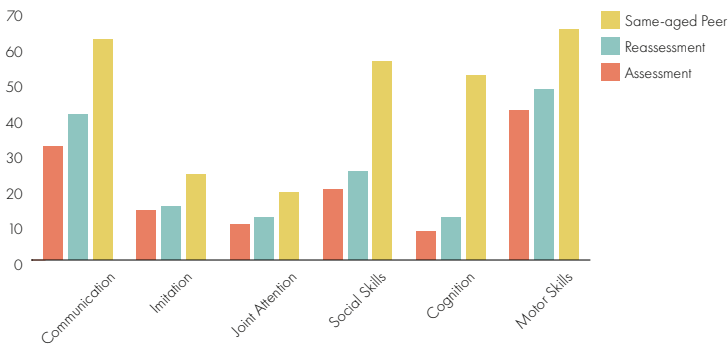
G-ESDM focuses on improving all of the developmental domains, including communication, social skills, motor skills, etc. within a term.

4. Is evidence based

The ESDM is backed by over 40 years of research to prove its effectiveness for children with autism.

5. Easily track progress

Children's skills can be easily tracked and compared to a same aged peer. Progress is reviewed quarterly to update and replace goals as the child gains success throughout the intervention.





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
